Scholarship Announcement for Students Impacted by ALS (Lou Gehrig's Disease)

ALS Ride for Life, Inc., a Long Island based not-for-profit patient-driven charity, has available annual scholarships for a graduating senior(s) who has had an ALS family member. The Scholarship winner will be notified on or about March 15, 2019 and money will be available and **made payable to the college** on or about August 1. This scholarship is funded by the philanthropic participation of Long Island educators, Long Island Teacher Unions, and generous business organizations.

Eligibility & Requirements

- 1) The student needs to **have a direct and verifiable family connection to ALS**: either a parent, stepparent, grandparent, uncle or aunt, or sibling.
- 2) The student must be a NY resident
- 3) The student must be accepted (or anticipate acceptance) to an accredited college and provide bursar's bill.
- 4) The applicant is required to complete an application including a brief essay explaining their family relationship to ALS and detailing any direct involvement with care giving, advocacy, etc.

Selection Process

- 1) A matrix prioritizing family relationship, student impact and residence of the applicant will determine the point value.
- 2) When there is a tie, a simple lottery will be used to determine the winner.
- 3) The successful candidate will need to verify eligibility.

Deadlines

- 1) Applications must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2019
- 2) Essay must be emailed to linumom@aol.com by March 1, 2019
- 3) Successful candidate will be contacted on or about March 15, 2019
- 4) A check will be made payable to the college on or about August 1, 2019
