Bellmore-Merrick's Drug Take Back Day is part of a larger ongoing nationwide effort to collect to collect unneeded prescription drugs, including controlled substances, for safe and legal disposal.

More than 2,000 teens (12-17) begin abusing prescription drugs **each day**, according to a recent SAMSHA teen survey. At the same time, drug addiction experts contend that abuse of narcotics such as painkillers are a gateway to illegal street drugs such as heroin.

We encourage all Bellmore-Merrick parents and community members to help fight prescription drug abuse by safely disposing of unwanted and expired medicines. The drug take back program provides a safe, convenient, and responsible way to dispose of prescription drugs, while also educating the community about the potential for abuse of medications. Additionally, the event helps the environment by discouraging people from using the typical disposal method, flushing unused pills or dumping them in the solid waste stream. This keeps them out of the drinking water system and landfills.
